Our Demonstrator for April Joe MacKechnie

Award winning Northwest artist and instructor, Joe Mac Kechnie, will present a mixed media demo at our April 19th meeting.

In recent studies, Joe continues to explore eye/brain interactions and how humans respond

differently to representational imagery compared to visually abstracted images. Using this knowledge, he will start with an abstract block-in of shapes and color, then refine these so that a pleasing balance between the abstracted and the representational emerges.
Joe is a member of the Portrait Society of America and Oil Painters of America as well as being a signature member of the Pastel Society of America, Northwest Watercolor Society, Northwest Pastel Society and Puget Sound Group of NW Artists. He has served as


president

Represented by galleries in Seattle and Alaska, his work has also been exhibited in the Butler Institute of American Art in Youngstown, Ohio and the National Arts Club Grand Gallery

Originally from Petersburg, Alaska, Joe was raised in the Pacific Northwest. He worked many years in the Seattle area as a computer network design engineer before pursuing a career in fine art.

Summer Break


This is an early reminder that EAFA will be on break for the monthly meetings during the months of June, July and August. We will still be active with the Public Arts Program and Plein air Program.
