Agreement

Acceptance of the following agreement is required to participate in the EAFA Public Art Program. Please read carefully, sign and date the form, and send it to Laura Grover, Program Manager (16827 16th Place, Bellevue 98008) or electronically to szak56@aol.com.

I agree that:

- EAFA acts as facilitator for the Public Arts program and does not receive a commission if art is sold. It selects member artists, schedules and installs EAFA member artworks for display. This is a volunteer program and participants are encouraged to volunteer.
- All artwork offered for exhibit in an EAFA Public Art venue shall remain at that venue for the duration of the exhibit except for exceptional circumstances.
- Sales of artwork at the venue are between the Buyer and the Artist. The artist is responsible for coordinating the sale with the buyer.
- Different Public Art venues have different art labeling requirements. Depending on the venue, the artist must supply information to the venue manager or provide labels.
- All paintings **must** have D rings with wire on the back of the painting. The Artist is responsible for attaching hardware to their artwork compatible with the hanging hardware supplied by the venue. Different Public Art venues have different hanging hardware requirements. The Public Art Venue Coordinators are responsible for communicating the requirements with the artist.
- Artist is encouraged to have insurance protection of their artwork against loss or damage. EAFA takes all precaution to protect art work from damage during the delivery, installation and removal process and is not responsible for any accidental loss or damage to artwork.
- Artist agrees to sign an agreement with the venue holding them harmless for any possible damage to the artwork during the installation.
- I agree that failure to observe these conditions may exclude me from participating in the EAFA Healing Arts program exhibitions.
